SWEAR IN OFFICIALS: Village Clerk Grider swore in Todd Lawson as Village Trustee.

VISITORS:

Craig Hall who is on the Sangamon County Board addressed the Village of Loami board on several items. Craig stated Sangamon County has a speed enforcement machine and asked if the Village of Loami would like to have Sangamon County bring the machine into town. Chief Workman stated he would like to have Sangamon County bring the machine. Mayor Mann asked Craig Hall if Sangamon County would be able to fix the roads in Loami and outside of Loami. Craig stated he would have the engineer for Sangamon County attend October's village board meeting. Craig Hall stated Sangamon County has broadband internet and they are hoping to push out the internet to towns in Sangamon County.
